

Hallsville ISD Pre-Kindergarten
2021-2022 Registration Information
Location: North Elementary on Billie Martin Parkway

Tuesday, July 27th – 11:00-7:00 Wednesday, July 28th – 9:00-5:00

Ways to qualify: (You must qualify in two of these ways and provide proof.)

1. The child must be 4 on or before September 1, 2021
2. The student must meet National Free or Reduced lunch criteria. Income is based on the **gross** amount of the **June income of everyone in the household. Bring June check stubs, proof of child support, Social security, etc.**
3. If the family receives food stamps (child qualifies automatically – **we must have Eligibility Group Number – EDG number, bring letter from Health and Human services with EDG number on it.**)
4. If a parent is currently on active military service – **bring proof.**
5. If a parent was wounded or killed on active military service – **bring proof.**
6. If the child is, or has been, in the conservatorship of the Dept. of Family and Protective Services - **bring proof.**
7. If the child is unable to speak or comprehend the English Language. **(These students will be tested to see if they qualify in this area.)**
8. If the parent of the child is eligible for the Star of Texas Award as a peace officer, firefighter, or emergency medical first responder - **bring proof**
9. **Complete all enrollment forms.**

What you need to bring with you to register on these dates:

Tuesday, July 27th – 11:00-7:00 Wednesday, July 28th – 9:00-5:00

Students will not be allowed to register if we do not have ALL of the required information.

Bring the following documents:

1. Bring proof of how you will qualify. (Must be one of the ways listed above.)
2. Bring proof of residence – lease/rental agreement or 2021 Harrison County Tax Statement.
(Electric bills cannot be used.)
3. Bring child's birth certificate.
4. Bring child's social security number.
5. Parent's driver's license to scan into our check in/out system
6. Current Immunization records Child must have 4 year old shots before school starts on August 12th. If their birthday is after August 12th, then they must have the shots before Sept. 1, 2021. To avoid the rush at doctor's offices, please make appointment now so you can have them done on or near their birthday so they will have their shots before Sept. 1. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE TO MAKE A DOCTOR APPOINTMENT.
7. Bring any guardianship or legal documents pertaining to the child.
