Required Dress Code SHIRTS



White collared or button down shirt is acceptable Short or long sleeved



Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in

Optional Dress Code Allowances

Students may wear a sweatshirt with no or minimal design for body temperature comfort in the classroom. **Collared shirt MUST be visible.**

Jackets with no hood





Unacceptable Dress Code Items

Hoodies are not allowed

Under no circumstances are hoodies allowed to be worn

Jackets with hoods are not allowed to be worn in the classroom.

Students will only be allowed to wear heavier jackets/coats and hoods when weather permits

OTHER DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS AND REMINDERS

- Shirts must be tucked in at the true waist at all times.
- Pants must be worn at the natural waist at all times (NO SAGGING)
- No headgear of any kind is allowed (i.e. hats, caps, bandanas, etc.)
- No hard metal or hard plastic hair clips are allowed
- No rings, watches, bracelets, necklaces, or large earrings are allowed
- No piercings other than small studs in ears. Clear spacers are allowed for nose piercings
- Inappropriate tattoos must be covered
- Hair must be neatly groomed at all times.
- Hair colors or hair arrangements that are distracting are not allowed.
- Hair must be pulled back and out of eyes/face at all times.
- Purses, backpacks, bags, etc. are not allowed.
- Feminine hygiene items must be checked in with the school nurse.
- Students may wear light, natural make-up, but may not bring make-up to school.



Dress Code will be checked every morning. If you're not sure if a clothing item is acceptable, please ask a DAEP staff member.

The DAEP administrator has the discretion to determine what is acceptable dress and grooming for DAEP.

Students must show up to the intake meeting in dress code in order to begin their placement the same day.
