DRESS CODE

Students placed in DAEP have lost many of the privileges that attendance at the regular campus affords. Students must wear a uniform at all times: Failure to comply with the dress code will result in disciplinary action. Before entering the building students must be in compliance with dress code guidelines.

DAEP Uniform:

Students must wear a white collared shirt with black, blue, or khaki pants. Jeans without holes are allowable. All shirts must be tucked in properly at all times. A belt must be worn at all times. Tennis shoes with laces are required to be worn at all times. Specifically prohibited footwear includes: boots, cleats, skate shoes or any shoes with wheels, house shoes, Crocs, sandals, and shoes of similar types are not allowed. No hoodies allowed. Students may bring a jacket/sweatshirt if needed

Jewelry

No jewelry of any kind is allowed. This includes but is not limited to

- Earrings
- Gauges
- finger rings
- belly rings, toe rings
- tongue rings/studs
- nose rings
- eyebrow rings
- lip rings
- Watches
- necklaces/chains
- wristbands/bracelets, etc.

Headgear and Hair

- No caps/hats of any kind are allowed at school. Leave all headwear at home.
- Students must have hair neatly groomed and naturally colored at all times. Hair colors or hair arrangements that are distracting are not allowed.
- Students will wear hair pulled back and out of eyes/face at all times.
- Mohawks or any distracting hair styles are not allowed.

^{**}No clear spacers, staples, etc. in place of jewelry may be worn. These items will be confiscated and will only be returned to the parent.

Miscellaneous

- No handkerchiefs, bandanas or any other display of colors are allowed.
- No Purses, backpacks, bags, etc. allowed in the classroom.
- No make-up, lipstick, carmex, eyeliner, mascara, etc. is allowed at school. Students may wear light, natural make-up, but may not bring items to school.
