IMPORTANT: JR. HIGH ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

We would like to make you aware, at Hallsville Jr. High attendance is taken <u>every class period</u>. Being tardy to school or leaving early will affect your child's attendance in the classes that are missed. The only exception to this is if your child misses a <u>partial day</u> for a medical appointment <u>and returns to school with an excuse from the medical professional</u> (Ex: doctor, dentist, counselor, etc.) Please remember that anytime a student is absent he/she must bring a note signed by the parent that describes the reason for the absence.

Under House Bill 5 (passed by the Texas legislature) all students in kindergarten through grade 12 must be in attendance 90% of the days a class is offered to receive credit for that class. Students missing more than 10% of course time for **any course** may be denied credit for that course. This policy applies to each class period during the school day. **Both excused and unexcused absences are included when determining 90% attendance.**

Your child will receive a progress report every 3 weeks and a report card every 9 weeks. Attendance will be printed on each progress report and report card. Please be aware of the number of absences your child has accumulated so that he/she will be in compliance with the 90% rule.

Our 7th and 8th grade students have the opportunity to receive High School credit for these courses:

Health (1 semester) PreAp Algebra 1 (full year)

PreAp Spanish 1 (full year)

Health (1 semester)

TSDE- Touch Systems Data Entry (1 semester)

The grades earned in these courses will be the first to appear on your student's High School transcript and will be calculated into his/her High School GPA. If a student is below 90% attendance in any of these courses, credit may be denied and will appear on the transcript with the notation "credit denied/attendance". In the one semester courses more than 9 absences can mean denial of credit for the course.

All parents are encouraged to take advantage of their <u>FAMILY ACCESS</u> account. This provides you with current information on your child's attendance, grades, assignments, and links to his/her teachers' email. You may access this by going to HISD homepage and clicking on the <u>FAMILY ACCESS</u> tab or type in <u>family.hisd.com</u> to see your account. You will use the same login and password that you used to register your student.
